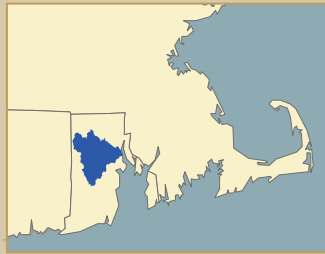


Pawtuxet Watershed

Lake Water Quality Status

Based on the 2010 assessments by RI DEM for aquatic life, recreation, and fish consumption



Lake Assessments:

- Aquatic Life (Fish & Wildlife Habitat)
- Recreational Use
- Fish Consumption

Blue means the water quality is acceptable.
Red means the water quality is not acceptable
 Gray means there is no or insufficient data

Lake Water Quality Status:

- █ Acceptable
- █ Partially acceptable
- █ Unacceptable
- █ Not assessed
- █ Other fresh surface water

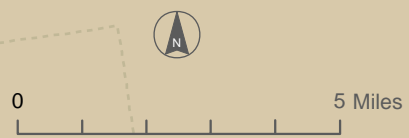
Dark Blue (acceptable) means one or more of the three uses are supported. There are no known impairments.

Yellow (partially acceptable) means one or two of the three uses are supported and one or two of the three uses are impaired.

Red (unacceptable) means at least one of the three uses is impaired and none are supported.

Gray (not assessed) means there is no or insufficient data for assessing the three uses.

In all cases there may be data gaps which prevent assessment of all uses for every lake.
